About the Study

- The Traumatic Brain Injury Model Systems (TBIMS) is:
 - A follow-up study funded by the Administration for Community Living
 - Composed of 19 hospitals across the US
- Your participation in TBIMS helps to:
 - Investigate factors related to maintaining good physical and mental health
 - Allocate resources, improve care, and inform policy

Eligibility

- Individuals who experienced a TBI
- At least 16 years of age
- English or Spanish-speaking
- Hospitalized and received rehabilitation at SCVMC

Participation

- ✤ 100% voluntary and can stop at any time
- Involves completing questionnaires, either by phone or by mail
- ✤ Has no in-person visits
- Occurs no more than once a year
