About the Study

- ❖ The Traumatic Brain Injury Model Systems (TBIMS) is:
 - ❖ A follow-up study funded by the Administration for Community Living
 - ❖ Composed of 19 hospitals across the US
- ❖ Your participation in TBIMS helps to:
 - ❖ Investigate factors related to maintaining good physical and mental health
 - ❖ Allocate resources, improve care, and inform policy

Eligibility

- ❖ Individuals who experienced a TBI
- ❖ At least 16 years of age
- ❖ English or Spanish-speaking
- ❖ Hospitalized and received rehabilitation at SCVMC

Participation

- ❖ 100% voluntary and can stop at any time
- ❖ Involves completing questionnaires, either by phone or by mail
- ❖ Has no in-person visits
- ❖ Occurs no more than once a year
