POLICY

SCVMC Interdisciplinary Outpatient Program provides a broad range of comprehensive coordinated outpatient medical and therapeutic services to meet the individualized strengths, cultural needs, age requirements, abilities and preferences for each person served. Typical diagnosis treated in the program include brain injury, stroke, spinal cord injury, major multiple trauma, orthopedic disorders, Guillain-Barre Syndrome, neuromuscular diseases, multiple sclerosis, polyneuropathy, limb amputations, arthritis, debility, medically complex, burn injuries, spina bifida, cerebral palsy, and post-polio.

Physical Medicine and Rehab Medical Services and Clinics (Monday-Friday, 8am - 5pm) Available by referral only

Services include:

- Debridement of (minor) decubiti
- Dietician consult
- Injection – tendon sheath, carpal tunnel, ligament, shoulder joint, or trigger point
- Nerve block (peripheral)
- Motor point blocks with botulinum toxin and phenol
- Suprapubic aspiration for bladder urine for culture and sensitivity
- Refills of implanted intrathecal baclofen pumps
- Tracheostomy changes
- Electrodiagnostic studies
- Gynecological examination

PMR Clinics-services provided by a physician experienced in Rehabilitation Medicine

Continuum of Care Programming – Provided by PT, OT and SLP

- Tier 1 – Within 6 months of initial onset
- Tier 2 – Post onset – 6 months to 1 year
 - Continued functional improvement
 - Focus on insuring community resource options are solidified
- Tier 3 – Post onset – 1 year through lifetime
 - Management of change of condition and focused needs
