Formulary Tips & Info:

- When searching for an item, click on the magnifying glass at the bottom of the document (do not use <Ctrl-F>, as this will not work).
- The formulary is organized by generic names (column A). Drugs that are non-formulary will not be listed in column A.
 - Stocking and dispensing of a particular manufacturer's generic versus brand medication will vary from time to time, and will be based on factors such as current product availability and pricing.
 - Column B shows current or legacy brand name(s) only for ease of searching, and will not indicate that the brand name would/should be stocked at any given time (see statement above regarding factors affecting stocking).
 - All bioequivalent formulations of the generic medication listed are considered on formulary, unless otherwise noted. If the medication is only on formulary for a specific indication, that will be noted.
 - The only drugs in this list that may have non-formulary status are those that have different inpatient versus outpatient formulary status (i.e. drug is formulary inpatient but non-formulary outpatient and vice versa).
- All strengths of any medication listed in this formulary list are considered on formulary, unless otherwise noted.
- Drugs in multiple pharmacologic class or pharmacologic subclass are combined with commas separating them.
 - Users can filter by a particular pharmacologic class or subclass with the arrow on the far right of the header column
 - How to Filter:
 - Click on the bottom arrow to the right of the column you want to search (i.e. pharmacologic subclass)
 - Uncheck "select all"
 - Type in the subclass you are interested in viewing (i.e. ACE inhibitors) --> hit "enter"
 - All the drugs in this class should be displayed (unless they are non-formulary).
 - To go back to the original formulary file, click on the same bottom arrow to the right of the column again and select "Clear Filter..."
- If a drug has multiple formulations or routes with different formulary status, only the route/formulation that is on formulary will be listed and the specific route/formulation will be included with the generic name (i.e. abatacept).
- For the "Special Notes" Column: If no setting is mentioned, that means the note/comment applies to all 4 formularies. However, if the comment only applies to some of the formularies/settings, then those respective formularies/settings will be explicitly stated.
